


NIKHIL AND JAY FLYING HIGH


About the themes in this book

Story 1: Accidents Happen

- a. Why do Nikhil and Jay get upset?
- b. When Appa slips and falls on the wet floor, whose fault is it?

 Is it Nikhil and Jay's fault, or is it Max's fault, or it was just an accident?
- c. How do you spend your time on a rainy day?
- d. What are the favourite board games you'd like to play if you cannot go outside to play?
- e. If someone was ill in your family, what can you do to make them feel better?





Story 2: A Pick-up Game

- a. What do Nikhil and Jay want to do over the weekend?
- b. What kind of activities do you do over the weekends?
- c. Do you think it will be fun for you to join your friends and clean your local park or street or beach?
- d. Do you know which kind of things should go into the recycle bin and which ones should be thrown into the rubbish?
- e. What is a wildlife garden? If you were to design a wildlife garden, what structures will you build?
- f. Have you been to a wild garden or meadow?

 Do you know how to create and maintain one?




Story 3: Flying High

- e. What does Nikhil miss by doing Jay's chores?






Bonus Explorations
