


Grandparents

Where do they live? Do you often visit them? Do they visit you? What's your favourite thing to do with your grandparents? Do they have pets?




Mango Madness

Colour in this bunch of mangoes?


Why don't you *draw a bowl* full of mangoes and colour it in too?



How do you celebrate your birthday? Is it different from how your grandparents used to celebrate?




Birthday Presents!

Draw one of the presents too.






Banana Feast

Can you draw a banana tree and colour it in?




Do not waste!

Remember - you can write and draw in your letter.




Stamps
